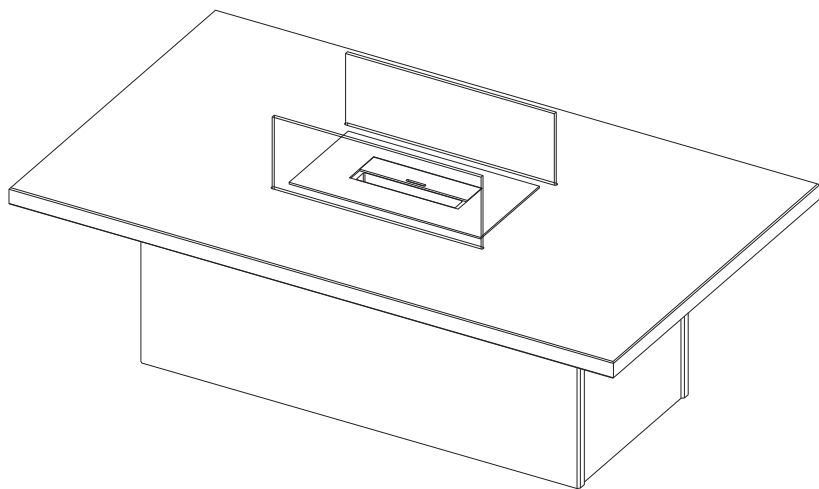


BIO ETHANOL MARBLE TABLE

Installation Guide

WARNING: Marble tables can weigh in excess of 120Kg (full set). Seek assistance when moving any of the components. **Do not attempt to lift any of the components alone.**



IMPORTANT: The correct selection and application of adhesives is essential in order to safely install this product.

PARTS SUPPLIED

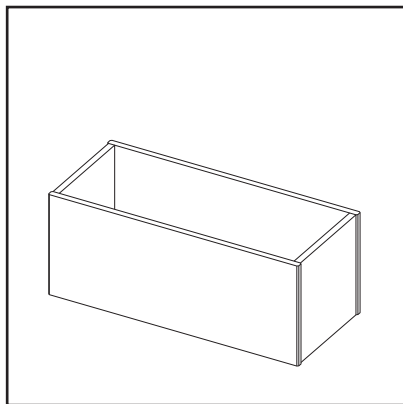
- Base

TOOLS & PARTS REQUIRED

- Silicone / Caulk

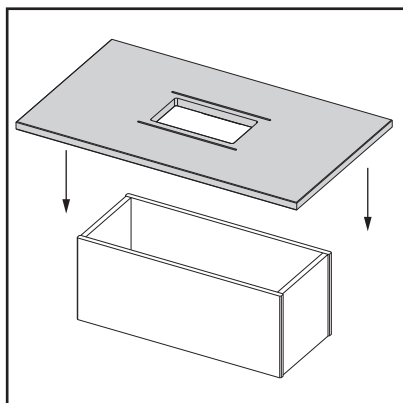
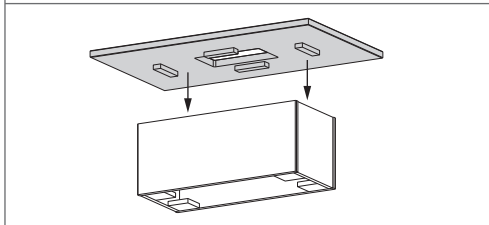
Installation

1. Carefully position the base on the floor.

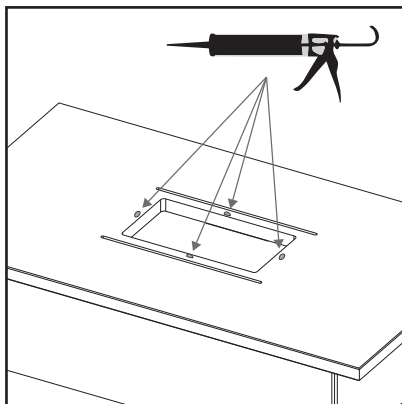


2. With help, gently lower the table top onto the base.

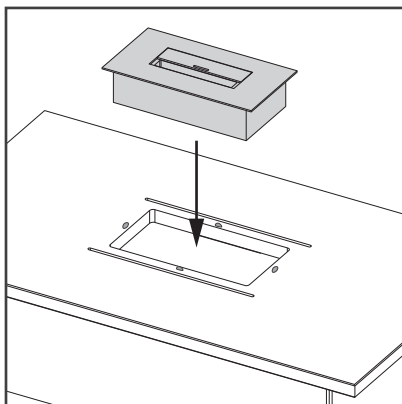
The locator blocks on the underside of the table top will ensure the top is central to the base.



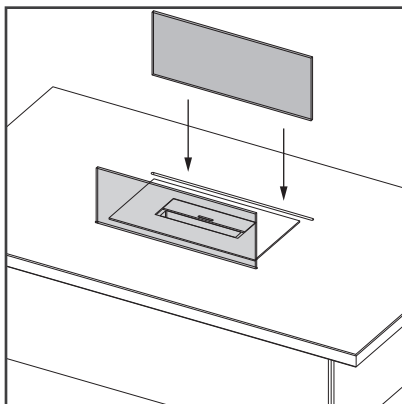
3. Apply 4 x pea sized dabs of silicone to the table top, close to the burner cut out.



4. Insert the burner into the table top.



5. Carefully insert the glass panels into the slots on the table top.



CARE AND MAINTENANCE

IMPORTANT: The structure of the table should be regularly checked for any evidence of instability.

IMPORTANT: Never allow children to sit, play or climb on any part of the table. The component parts of the table are extremely heavy, should any part becomes dislodged it could cause serious or fatal injury.

IMPORTANT: Take care not to place or store any heavy objects on the table.

Extinguish the fire and allow to cool before cleaning.

Marble and granite are porous materials and are very delicate where liquids are concerned.

Strong acidic or alkali substances such as wine, coffee, tea, fruit juice, lemon juice, vinegar, carbonated soft drinks or toiletries can stain or etch the surface. If anything is spilt on the marble, even water, it should be cleaned immediately.

Use coasters to prevent damage from glasses and cups.

Take care when cleaning; polished surfaces and edges can be easily scratched.

Do not use cleaning agents or abrasive wipes, these will damage the marble by etching or wearing away the surface.

CLEANING

1. Dust down the surfaces with a soft duster.
2. Only use warm water; cleaning agents, bleach, soaps or furniture polish will damage the material. For granite products, you can use specialist granite cleaners.
3. Use a soft sponge to soak up the warm water and ring out thoroughly.
4. Wipe down the surfaces of the material.
5. Use a soft, dry cloth to dry the surfaces immediately after cleaning.
