

DO'S


- Read **ALL** the instructions before using this product.

- Always install the product in accordance with this guide. If in doubt obtain expert advice.
- Always check your mains supply is the same as that indicated on the product before connecting, if applicable to this product.
- Always make sure the electrical socket is accessible and located adjacent to, but not above the appliance, if applicable to this product.
- Always ensure that the correct tools are used toinstall this appliance.
- Always make sure the product is firmly secured to the wall when complete.
- Always use a Gas Safe Engineer to install the gas fire if applicable.

DON'TS

- · Not suitable for solid fuel fires

- 1. Screw the 'header' to 'leg 1' & 'leg 2'.
- 2. Screw this to the 'shelf'.
- 3. Remove the 3 x 'rebate strips' if required.



INSTALLATION

- 1. Install hearth & back panel.
- 2. Mark & drill 4×100 (Approx. 6mm x 35mm deep) for the 2×100 wall brackets to the distances shown in figure iii.
- 3. Insert the wall plugs and screw the brackets to the wall. (If the wall isn't solid i.e plasterboard, then purchase the correct fixings).
- 4. Lift the surround and hook the surround brackets over the top of the wall brackets so the surrounds sits on top of the hearth (Figure i.).
- 5. Ensure the surround is secured.
